

The story of Little Dorothy and the Wizard of Oz, forever remains.



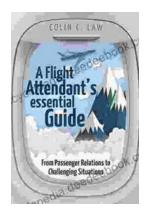
