Map of Sweet Secrets

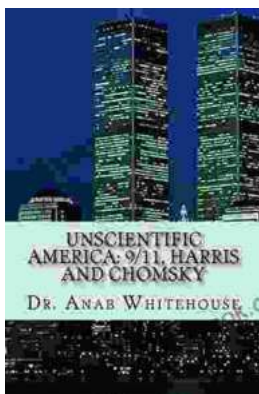

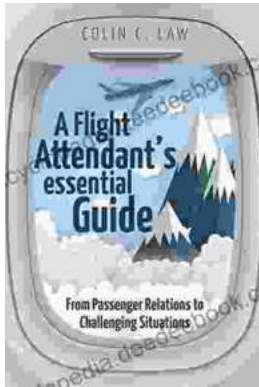
