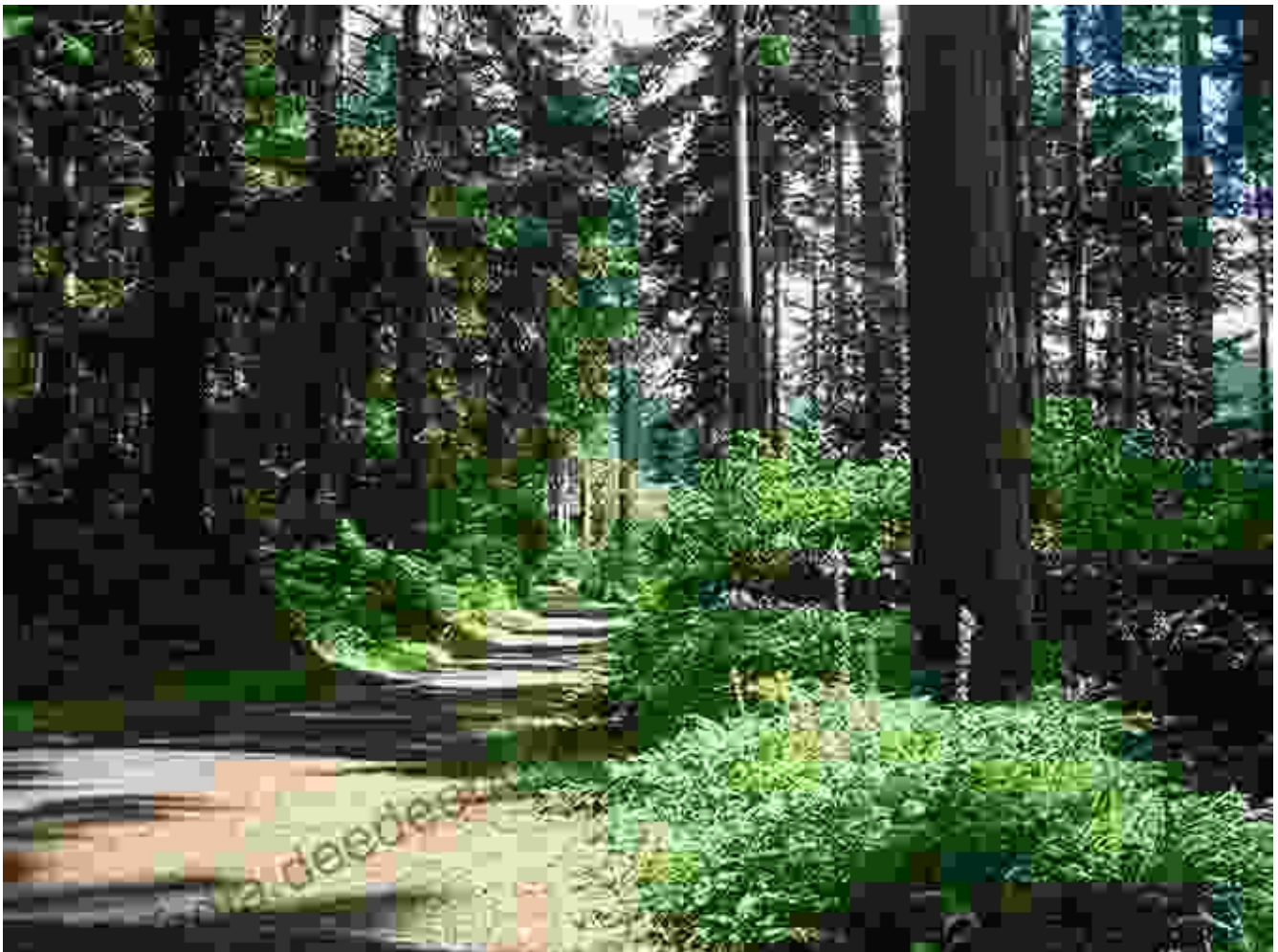
Coed y Brenin

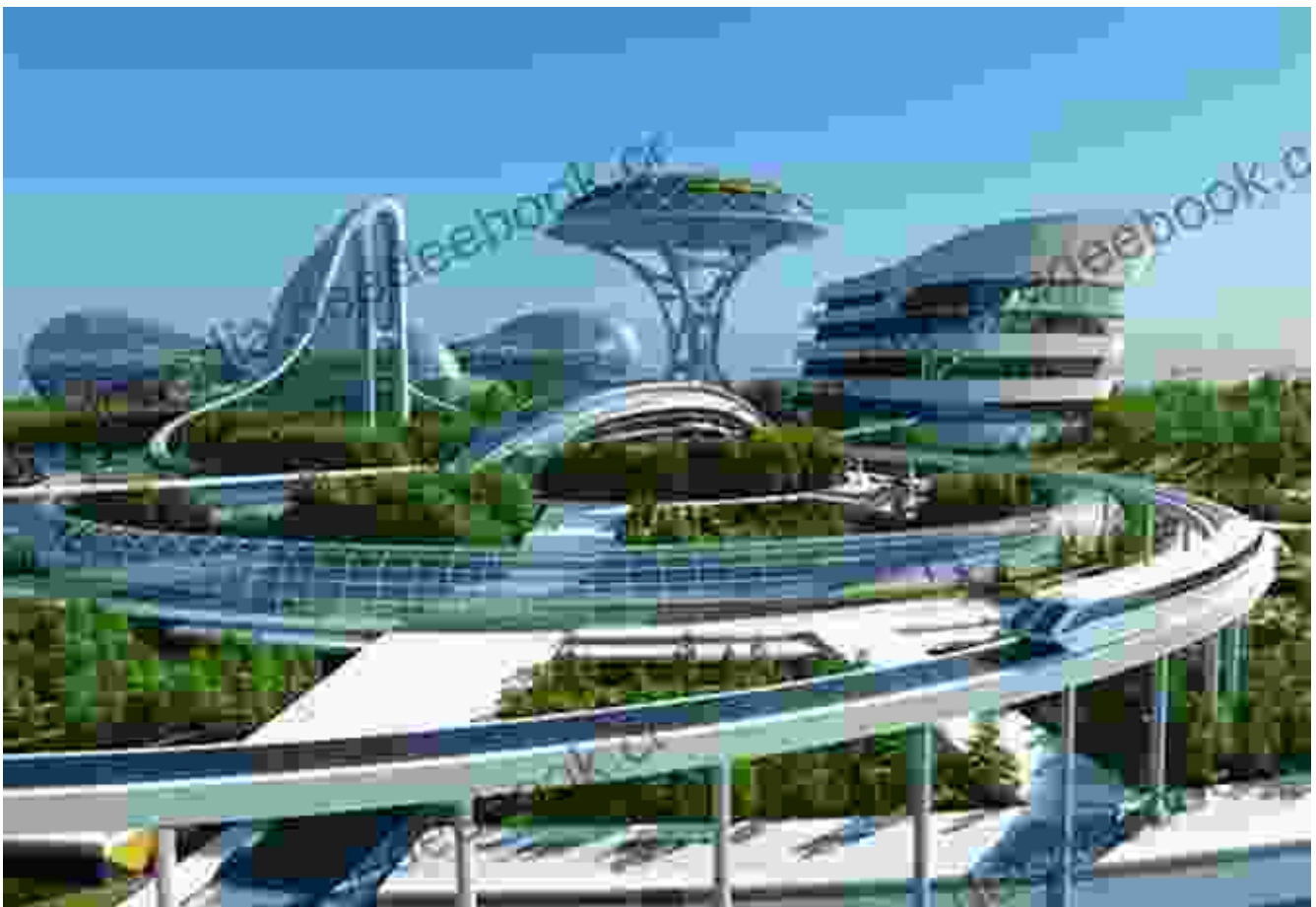

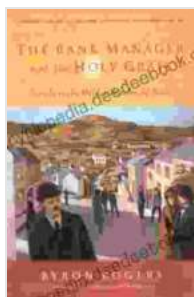
